BronxWorks staff and Executive Director Eileen Torres joined our partners at L+M Development Partners, Type A Projects, and elected officials to cut the ribbon on Bronx Point, a new multi-use building opening in the South Bronx! Bronx Point will house to the Universal Hip-Hop Museum, as well as 542 new affordable housing units, with 82 reserved for formerly homeless residents. BronxWorks will provide social services for those units and will also run an early childhood learning center on the ground floor.
