

## BronxWorks Accomplishments for 2024

### Feed

- Prepared 459,140 meals for Bronx residents most vulnerable to food insecurity
- Distributed 53,835 grocery bags that contained 227,722 pounds of food with an estimated value of \$2,691,750 that led to the preparation of 366,419 meals for an average of 5,163 people each month
- Secured SNAP benefits with an annual value of \$472,238 for 208 households

### Shelter

- Temporary shelter was provided to about 3,289 people, including 2,069 single homeless adults and 569 families with about 1,220 people
- Placed 511 individuals or households into permanent housing
- Provided rent arrears assistance totaling \$2.3 million to 2,371 households who were at risk of eviction

### Teach

- Early childhood programs enrolled 205 pre-school aged children, while out of school time, school transition, and attendance improvement programs for school-aged youth enrolled 2,715
- Cornerstone community centers in or near public housing complexes offered educational and recreational activities for 17,326 people, including youth, working age adults, and seniors
- Older adult centers provided 2,846 educational activities to 1,836 seniors

### Support

- Free income tax services were provided to 7,883 filers who received \$8.2 million in federal refunds
- Legal and ESOL assistance was provided to 1,594 immigrants
- Enrolled 6,685 households into a health insurance plan
- Benefits and entitlements assistance was provided to 2,882 people leading to the acquisition of \$1.6 million in public benefits
- Placed 1,445 youth into internships or jobs and 317 adults into jobs
