Barrett is a founding Principal of PSF Projects Architecture, a woman-owned, award-winning firm, where she leads the practice's nonprofit, educational, and research work. Recent projects include work at Columbia University and SUNY Purchase College. Prior to co-founding PSF Projects, she held roles at GLUCK+, Mack Scogin Merrill Elam Architects, and Rogers Marvel Architects, with projects including Lady Liberty Charter School, the Austin Federal Courthouse, and Battery Park City Streetscapes.

Barrett holds a Bachelor's Degree with High Honors in Studio Art from Wesleyan University, where she later returned to teach. She has a Master's Degree in Architecture from the Graduate School of Design at Harvard University and subsequently received a Fulbright Fellowship funding a year in Tokyo studying public space.

A mother and believer in the principle of *'repairing the world'* instilled by her parents, Barrett joined the BronxWorks Board driven by a commitment to ensure that care is not only expressed by its remarkable staff but also felt in the spaces and places BronxWorks creates. She believes a stronger Bronx will make for a stronger New York City.
