



## BronxWorks Accomplishments for 2025

### Feed

- Prepared 534,010 meals for Bronx residents most vulnerable to food insecurity
- Distributed 51,916 grocery bags that led to the preparation of 466,650 meals for an average of 2,572 families each month
- Secured SNAP benefits for 622 households with an annual value over \$166,809

### Shelter

- The BronxWorks Homeless Outreach Team engaged with 4,888 unique individuals in the Bronx
- Placed 618 individuals or households into permanent housing
- Provided rent arrears assistance totaling \$3.8 million to 2,993 households who were at risk of eviction
- 1,050 households received legal representation to avoid eviction

### Teach

- Early childhood programs enrolled 97 pre-school aged children, while out of school time, school transition, and attendance improvement programs for school-aged youth enrolled 2,030 youth ages 5-24.
- Cornerstone community centers in or near public housing complexes offered educational and recreational activities for 1,379 children & youth
- Older adult centers provided 8,978 educational and other group activities to 3,196 seniors

### Support

- Free income tax services were provided to 8,531 filers who received \$8.97 million in federal refunds
- Enrolled 6,927 households into a health insurance plan
- Benefits and entitlements assistance was provided to 3,209 people leading to the acquisition of \$555,923 in public benefits
- Placed 1,069 youth into internships or jobs and 283 adults into jobs
- In all, BronxWorks provided services to nearly 66,000 residents.
